The next product being released to the Grandstream Beta Club is a medium capacity network video recorder (NVR). The device supports all Grandstream surveillance products as well as all ONVIF compliant IP cameras. A live feed can view up to 16 cameras simultaneously and the NVR can save up to 4TB of video files. Users can connect Grandstream's NVR to an external computer or TV monitor using the VGA or HDMI output to view recordings, monitor live feeds and adjust settings. The device supports up to 2 SATA 2.5" easily swappable hard drives (without opening the case), and includes 1 Gigabit network port. 30 units of the NVR will be available starting June 30th.
